Assertive Mentoring Programme (AMP)

This week, children from Years 2-6 will be having their 1:1 mentoring meeting with their class teacher. In the meeting, they will discuss their individual targets; both academic (writing, maths, spelling, reading, times tables) and attitude (behaviour, uniform, homework, attendance, punctuality, effort) Children are given a colour - red (below), yellow (on track) or green (above) - at the end of each half-term.
