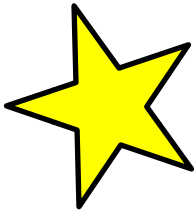
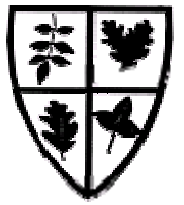
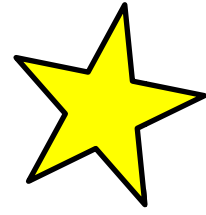


Woodhall School News
