Dear Parents/Carers,

Just a few reminders of the precautionary measures that we continue to take at Woodhall to help minimise the risk of contracting/spreading COVID-19:

- ALL meetings with parents/governors/other visitors will take place in our Community Room. If you have a meeting, please use the separate entrance on Woodhall Lane (the entrance used for Nursery/Reception) A signing-in sheet will be available in the Community Room, and the member of staff you are meeting will be there to greet you. The Community Room is large and well-ventilated. It is easy to remain socially-distanced. Therefore, face coverings are worn at your discretion.
- Children remain in bubbles of 2 year groups (Nursery and Reception; Year 1 & 2; Years 3 & 4; Years 5 & 6) This enables us to share play space at play/lunchtimes and allows a small degree of socialising with children from another class, which is important for children's social and emotional well-being. Bubbles do not mix.
- A separate letter reminding everyone of attendance procedure will be sent out shortly.

However, our advice remains the same:

- If a child is showing any of the 3 main symptoms of COVID-19 (high temperature/a new, continuous cough/loss of smell and/or taste) then they need to isolate for 10 days and/or get tested. Please phone the NHS on either 111 or 119 for further advice.
- You can arrange a test via www.nhs.uk/coronavirus or by calling 119. The child and all their household will need to self-isolate at home whilst awaiting the results. If a child is tested and the test comes back as negative, they may return to school.
- If your child has been in contact with a suspected case of COVID-19, they need to complete 14 days self-isolation.

If your child needs to self-isolate, please let us know. Where there is a confirmed case of COVID-19, we must notify Hertfordshire County Council. We will also provide your child with home learning for the duration of the time that they are away from school.
