DINNER MONEY

A reminder that all dinner money must be paid at the beginning of each week: £15.75 per week or £3.15 per day. Children choose from a range of options each day. Options include a hot meal, a vegetarian option and either a jacket potato or sandwich. Delicious!

Your child might qualify for free school meals if you are in receipt of any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (as long as you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and you don't get more than **£16,190** a year)
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit (with annual earned income of no more than **£7,400** after tax and not including any benefits you get).
