## **'SEE HOW WE LEARN' CLASS WORKSHOPS**

We are pleased to bring you the return of our class workshops, where you are warmly invited to come into school and join your child for the afternoon. Each class teacher will introduce a particular subject/focus area and talk about how this is taught within their classroom, including the basic concepts taught and 'ways into' learning such as games or other hands-on activities. Teachers will also give advice on how you might support your child at home.

Workshops will take place on the following afternoons and run from 2-3pm:

TUESDAY 26th SEPTEMBER: Sharks Class (Year 6) Reading with upper Key Stage 2 children ('VIPERS')

WEDNESDAY 27th SEPTEMBER: Starfish Class (Years 1 & 2) Phonics

TUESDAY 17th OCTOBER: Dolphins Class (Year 3/4) Maths – learning through games

WEDNESDAY 18th OCTOBER: Turtles Class (Y4/5) Grammar

#### EARLY YEARS (NURSERY/RECEPTION) WORKSHOP

This will be slightly different to the other workshops, as we thought that it would be helpful to provide parents with an overview of the Early Years curriculum. This workshop will be for parents only; the children will remain in class. If you are the parent of a Nursery child and attending the workshop might be tricky for you in terms of childcare, please speak to Miss Jones.

#### **HOMEWORK**

Homework is a very important part of a child's education and can add much to a child's development. Children benefit greatly from the mutual support of parents and teachers in encouraging them to learn both at home and at school. One of the aims of our school is for children to develop as independent learners, and we believe that homework is one of ways in which children can acquire the skill of independent learning.

Your child's class teacher will email you regarding the day that homework is set in their class, the format in which it should be completed and when work should be handed in for checking or marking.

At Woodhall, children from Year 1-Year 6 are set a daily phonics/reading task. Children from Years 1-6 will also be set a maths task, based on number bonds/times tables. Other tasks, including online learning (using specified educational websites), project work or home learning in subjects other than maths/English will be set by each class teacher as appropriate.

Outstanding examples of homework or good attitudes towards completing homework are always celebrated in class, and often in our Friday celebration assembly too!

### **STEP 2 SKILLS: THE MULTIPLY PROJECT**

We are very excited that Woodhall will be hosting the Step 2 Skills Multiply Project, a series of interactive and engaging workshops to support parents who would like to build up their maths skills and confidence. Dates/times etc. will be confirmed as soon as possible.
