# **ROAD SAFETY: WOODHALL LANE**

During the week beginning Monday 20<sup>th</sup> November, we are taking part in National Road Safety Week. This will include the whole school. Children will take part in a series of assemblies and class-based activities, where we will use some of the 'Be Bright, Be Seen!' resources.

However, we have experienced a couple of worrying incidents recently and have spoken to the children about keeping safe, particularly on Woodhall Lane at drop-off and pick-up times. Please talk to your child/ren at home about road safety, and especially the following:

- > Only open car doors when an adult tells you that it is safe to do so and always get out of the door NEXT TO the pavement. Never open your car door onto the road.
- Only cross the road where it is safe to do so. If you are on a bike or a scooter, dismount before you cross the road. Check left, check right and then check again before you cross.

We have had children walking/running straight out into the road without looking and a couple of very near-misses, even when the drivers have been driving very slowly and sensibly.

Unfortunately, some cars (that are nothing to do with Woodhall) travel very fast along Woodhall Lane and/or use it as a cut-through. They would not be able to stop quickly if a child suddenly walked out into the road. We have spoken to Hertfordshire County Council about the lack of sensibly-placed signage to warn cars to slow down as there is a primary school ahead.

Many of our Year 5 and Year 6 children walk to/from school by themselves, which gives them a important taste of independence and prepares them for moving on to secondary school. However, we do want them to be safe and well. If there are older children who are not being safe and sensible on their journeys to/from school, we will ask that they be dropped off and collected by a parent.
