

English

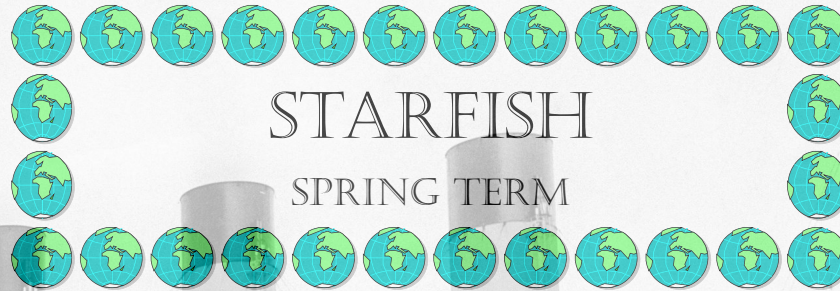

Mathematics

Maths this term will start with learning about measure (including mass, length and height), equality and comparison, and geometry. This should be a fun half term of learning with plenty of physical activities and games that we can play to make our learning even more enjoyable. In the second half term we will continue our learning about number. Looking at addition and subtraction, regrouping, strategy choice and problem solving, doubling and halving and even moving on to multiplication.



R.E.

This term in RE we will be looking at Judaism. Learning about religious symbols, imagery and places of worship that are important to Jews around the world. Thinking about Jewish festivals and how Jewish children express their beliefs.

Geography

We will be learning about the 4 compass points this term which will help us to plot the route of the Titanic in history. We will also look at the hot and cold areas around the world.

Phonics

This term is all about getting ready for the phonics screening that will be happening in June for the Year 1 children. They will be quickly working through level 4 phonics then moving on to level 5. covering new sounds and improving out blending. The older children will continue working on Level 6 phonics improving their spelling.

History

The Titanic! Legendary ship that sank after hitting an iceberg. This will be the basis of our history research topic this term. We will learn and research all about why we remember the Titanic, why it sank, the route it took and how children had fun on board. We will also, later in the term, look at Mayday and perform a maypole dance.

Computing

We will be learn the importance of following instructions to complete tasks and consider how the order of instructions affects the results.

P.S.H.E.

Continuing on with our PSHE lessons linked to our school values, we will be looking at Responsibility and Passion this term. We will discuss the meaning of these words and how we can show them in our everyday lives.

Art

This term in art, we will learn about Hilma af Klint, a famous Swedish artist, whose paintings are considered among the first abstract works known in Western art history. We will work on our painting skills and introduce collage to recreate some of her

Science

This term in science, we will be learning about animals and the habitats and environments that they live in, how they are adapted to these different environments and the things they need to do to survive in them. We will learn all about the differences between something that is alive, dead or something that has never been alive and be able to categorise groups of things into these categories. At the end of the term we will be designing and building our own bug hotels that will hopefully be the perfect environment for some minibeasts around the school grounds.
