Big Garden Birdwatch is the world's largest garden wildlife survey. Every year, hundreds of thousands of people take part, helping to build a picture of how our garden birds are faring. In assembly today, we talked about how to be involved. You don't even need to have a garden! Children can simply look out of a window and record the garden birds that they see, or go to a local park and do the same.

If your child would like to take part, survey forms will be available at school. The easiest way to let the RSPB know what you saw is by logging your results online at www.rspb.org.uk/birdwatch. However, you can also complete a survey, bring it back to school and I will submit them all by post. If you see a bird that's not included on the RSPB list, make a note of it. The RSPB love to hear about other birds that you have seen. Good luck and happy birdwatching!
