## WOODHALL'S MAY DAY

We are very proud to be a school whose May Day traditions are very much alive and kicking. This year, we will celebrate on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May, and you are all invited. Come and see this year's May Queen crowned and marvel at Robin Hood and the Merry Men! Enjoy a cup of tea or coffee whilst taking in a variety of dancing, from the Dolphins' Morris Dancing Team to Year 6's Country Dance...

You are invited to take your seats from 9.50am. The children will come out at approximately 10am when the festivities will begin. We anticipate that the event will run until around 11.30pm, when the children will return to class.

In order to let as many parents as possible attend, May Day will be held on our lower playground. Should the weather be bad, we will notify you as soon as possible and re-schedule.

## SCHOOL ENTRANCE ON LITTLE OXHEY LANE

You might be aware that there is an entrance gate to the school located on Little Oxhey Lane (opposite the turning for Cherry Hills). This entrance has been closed for a number of years.

We would like to re-open this entrance (MORNINGS ONLY) from Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April. To do this safely, we would ask those using this entrance to adhere to the following:

- If your child is in Year 1-Year 6, they must be dropped at the gate and can make their way to classrooms from there. Only parents of children in Early Years (Nursery/Reception) will be allowed to accompany their child down to the Office entrance.
- > Parents/carers cannot use the entrance to walk through to Woodhall Lane (i.e. as a cut through)
- > The gate will be opened at 8.30am and closed at 8.50am.
- If you need to talk to a class teacher, please make an appointment by emailing the teacher or phoning the School Office. Unfortunately, teachers are not able to speak to parents from 8.30am onwards as they are with the children in 'Soft Start'.

## CROSSING THE ROAD

We know that Little Oxhey Lane is a busy road and this has been a real concern for us. We have spoken to Hertfordshire County Council about the possibility of having a crossing patrol at this entrance (there was originally a crossing patrol but this was taken away by the Council).

In order for the Council to consider installing a crossing patrol, we have been asked to conduct a trial run. A Council Officer will then come out to see the entrance being used and decide whether or not a crossing patrol is needed.

**During the trial run, there will be no-one to help the children cross Little Oxhey Lane.** A school adult will be on the entrance gate, but this person will be making sure that children are getting to their classes and therefore not able to help children across the road.

Please make sure that there is an adult crossing with your child during this time.

If the trial run is successful, we hope that the Council will agree to a crossing patrol.

## HOME TIME

Unfortunately, we are not able to open the Little Oxhey Lane entrance at home time. This is because we cannot provide the number of staff needed to take children out to both entrances. However, if demand is there, we will consider options moving forward.
