Almost at the end of September, and we're all off to a **flying start** with our autumn term learning! By now, you should have received the **termly curriculum outline** for your child's class. This lets you know what is being studied in each subject across the curriculum. You can see that, wherever possible, teachers create a **meaningful**, **interconnected context for learning** so that children's **engagement is enhanced** and a **deeper understanding is developed** by linking different subjects and real-world experiences to a theme. Shared class books provide a great basis for wider curriculum learning. Here's a quick 'book look' for each class...

**Kingfishers:** 'Escape from Shangri La' by Michael Morpurgo. This poignant tale is about a young girl named Cessie who tries to help her grandfather escape from the nursing home where he is placed and uncover the truth of his experiences on the beaches of Dunkirk. It's a great read for children and adults alike, and links brilliantly into the children's learning about **World War Two** – especially for our Year Six children, who will be presenting our annual 'Woodhall Remembers' event on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> November.

In our **Puffins** class, the children will be having huge fun reading various titles from the **'Mr.Men'** series (originally written by **Roger Hargreaves**), and they will eventually design, make and evaluate their own books in their Design & Technology lessons; learning how to cut, fold, create structures and attractive designs.

Our little Early Years Parrots have been busy exploring their own lives...their families, homes, likes and dislikes and so on. As part of this theme (and in preparation for making their own 'lift-the-flap' style books), Nursery have been reading 'Dear Zoo' by Rod Campbell and 'All Kinds of People' by Emma Damon. We can't wait to see their own creations! Reception are enjoying 'You Can!' by Alexandra Strick and Steve Antony.

**Year One** – our big **Parrots** – are enjoying *'Someone Just Like You' by* **Helen Docherty and David Roberts**, which they are using as a stimulus for learning how to use capital letters and write lists, labels and captions. This provides a lovely link to their **PSHE learning**: *'All About Me!'*.

There are so many great books out there that it can be tricky to choose what to read together at home! 
